What is RHC70s.org

RHC70s.org (sometimes called RHC65-85.org) is essentially an association/ friends group set up to enable people who were in a particular place (Royal Holloway College) at a particular time (between 1965 and 1985) to get in touch with one another with minimal difficulty while providing a degree of privacy to all involved. It is a way to share any memories member's wish to share and communicate with one another.

Your right to be a member is based solely on the criteria of having been in the right place at the right time.

We have two methods of communication – A website and a mailing list.

RHC70s.org (aka RHC65-85.org) Website

- The website is open to any alumni who was at Royal Holloway College between 1965 and 1985. It does not require all their student years to be during that period nor for them to have completed and passed their degree.
- When joining the website you will need to provide a valid email address and confirm your name when a student, your subject and your years of attendance in order to validate your membership. You will also be asked to provide your current name (so we know how to address you). Any other information is optional. These details, apart from your email address, will appear on your account profile. You will also need to select a username and password.
- From time-to-time the website owner may let others have an associate membership of the site for research for a specific project. This does not give them access to any email addresses and their use of any material on the site will require them to request permission to make use of any material (photos in particular) from the site.
- The Alumni team at the College will also have access to the site (with those same restrictions placed upon them). However, the website is dependent on the College in many cases to confirm the alumni details

(including the email address) on the application for membership to be confirmed so they will also receive your email address.

- In order to see photos and other material from the period or to see anyone else's membership details you will have to sign in with a username and password.
- Your email address will be added to the Mailing list but you can remove yourself from this whenever you receive an email sent through it.
- The website includes several documents which provide details of the Term's and Condition's for the use of the site together with a Privacy statement and Cookies policy. These can all be accessed via the footer at the bottom of most pages on the website.

Mailing List

- Everyone who joins the RHC70s website get automatically added to the RHC70s mailing list (which uses a service called Mailchimp).
- The mailing list also includes alumni who have chosen not to join the website but are known to be alumni from the period. Any alumni can choose to be removed from the mailing list at any time.
- The main purpose of the mailing list is to keep alumni informed about reunions which take place from time to time and to advise people about major changes to the website.
- Every direct mail that is sent via Mailchimp includes an option to have your email address removed, once removed that email address will not get added back in.
- If you unsubscribe from the mailing list you can continue to be a member of the website (but may not receive important updates).
